RULES AND CONDITIONS

All Exhibitors entering shall be considered as having read the following Rules and Regulations. Anything not covered shall be decided by the Chairman and Committee in consultation with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society or with the Show Veterinary Surgeon in cases calling for their opinion.

1. **JUDGES.** The Judges decisions are final. The Committee reserve the right to substitute any judge in the unlikely event of a cancellation. The Judges may withhold any prize where there is evident want of merit, where there is only one entry shown in a class, the Judges may award the first, second, third or fourth prize according to the merit of that entry.
2. **CANCELLATION OF CLASSES.** Any class with insufficient entries may be amalgamated with a class of the same type.
3. **OBJECTIONS.** Objections shall be made in writing with the objector's full name and address within one hour of the event concerned, and lodged at the Secretary's Office together with the sum of £15.00 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained, but if the objection is not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the

4. **ENTRY FEES.** We very much regret that entry fees cannot be refunded, the only exception to this rule would be with a veterinary certificate stating that the horse or pony in question is unfit for competition, or if the show had to be cancelled for any unforeseen circumstances.
5. **RULES IN GENERAL.** All Exhibitors, grooms and all other persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Show. The Northern All Welsh Medal Shows will not be responsible in anyway for any loss, damage or injury to animals, people and their property from any cause or circumstances whatever. Acceptance of the Rules and Regulations of the Northern All Welsh Medal Shows shall be a condition of entry.
6. **ENTRIES.** All Welsh ponies must be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society and the registration number MUST be shown on the entry form. Registration number of DAMS AND SIREs MUST also be shown on the entry form. ANY ENTRIES NOT COMPLETE WILL BE RETURNED.
7. **W.P.C.S. MEDALS.** W.P.C.S. Medals to be awarded to the Champion or Reserve of each Section of the Stud Book, as per the Regulations governing Medal Awards of the W.P.C.S.
8. **PARKING.** Wagons and cars must only be parked as instructed by the Stewards on duty, access roads must not be used for parking.
9. **STABLING.** Anyone requiring stabling should contact the secretary as soon as possible and we will do our best to organise.
10. **MEDICAL COVER.** All exhibitors are asked to include an additional £2.00 with their entries to cover the cost of the attendance of Paramedics.
11. **ANY PONY STALLION** not exceeding 138cms OR Small Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions – i.e. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & Welsh B - may NOT be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 12th birthday before 1st January. Any -Small Breed Mountain and Moorland Stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed Mountain & Moorland stallions – i.e. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh Section C & Welsh Section D –may not be ridden by any Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January.

- iii) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (NB Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive year provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv) If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately denoviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final. **Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.**
